- Those with Dementia perhaps exhibiting behavioural and psychological symptoms, particularly if it causes distress and results in risky behaviour.



What we offer

- Explore the current needs, frequency and intensity of presenting issues – exclude physical causes
- Identify risks and ways to reduce them
- Consider treatment options – social engagement, medication and advice re/ telecare.
- Therapy
- Carer support and education. Sign posting to other support services.
